Integrated Mental Health/Substance Abuse Grants with Medical Home**

RFA Deadline

The Request for Application deadline is 5:00 pm on March 15, 2010. Electronic submission only.

RFA Process

A pre-grant meeting with a Program Officer is required prior to submission. See website (www.kbr.org) for geographic assignments of program officers and further information on the advanced consultation process. The application for this RFA will follow our standard submission and notification schedule.

Eligibility

Nonprofit (501c3) organizations and governmental entities working on prevention and treatment issues consistent with the Trust's mental health services areas of emphasis, including substance abuse and integrated care.

Special Parameters

RFA must focus on integration or co-location of care in close affiliation with a medical care home (as defined in our medical care home area of emphasis). Applications of special promise that incorporate prevention and planning efforts as part of integration and co-location will also be considered.

Selection Criteria

Special consideration will be given to applications that feature one or more of the following:

- Replication, enhancement or piloting of best practices approaches identified in the IOM Substance Abuse report (http://www.nciom.org/projects/substance_abuse/Full%20Report.pdf)
- The work of local consortia or collaborations interested in testing new approaches.
- Work that has a strong potential for incorporation into emerging governmentally supported mental health and substance abuse structure.
- Early identification and treatment of mental health and substance abuse issues for underserved populations (adolescents, older adults etc).
- Practices that show evidence of innovation, impact and cost-effectiveness.

Grant Funds Available

Up to \$600,000 will be made available under this RFA. Maximum grant award will be \$125, 000. All grants are limited to one year terms only.
